L.G.Brookman wrote 3/15/1942:

"The rarest item I ever owned was a copy of #36 that was printed on both sides. I picked this up when I was first starting to fool around with stamps about a dozen years ago. Bought it for \$10 and sold it (to pay a debt) for a magnificent profit of 10%! I think this is a copy that has not been recorded in such records as exist of this item. The printing on the back was good and showed portions of four stamps as

it was not centered in relation to the front of the stamp. It is not impossible that I can check up on the present ownership and get a photo of it. Souren had a copy that he showed me in Denver at a stamp show a few years ago and told me that only 3 copies were known. I told him about the 4th copy but don't know that he believed me."

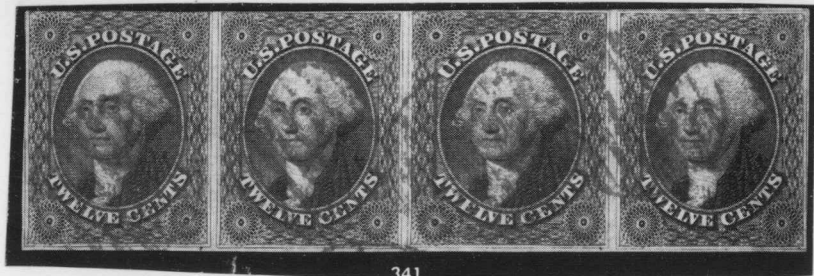

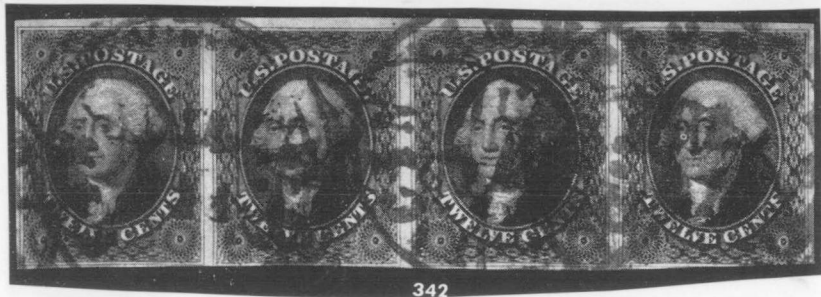

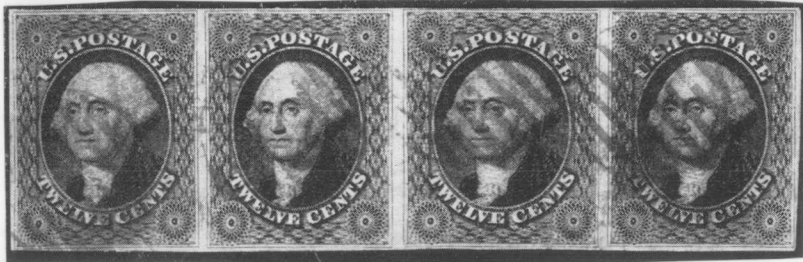
