Lot 400 - Half of 12c (36), used as 6c, from California to SURREY, Maine, stamp canc. SONORA, CALIFORNIA, DEC. 29, 1851, in two lines squarely across the stamp; another cover with the same canc., to the same address and from the same "find" goes with this cover. It is believed this is the only copy extant with the 1851 year date and that the cover is absolutely unique. It is safe to say that it cannot be duplicated, but the statement still remains unchallenged. It is easily the gem of the sale so far. Condition is A-No.1

Parker writes: "I note stamp is tied with small dots - Items this early from Sonora are scarce thus I have no record of such a killer. This type P.M. I call Sonora Type 2. It came into use after great fire June 17-18-1852, which no doubt burned the straight line type Early use of this small circle type 2 was generally struck in orange or red and in short time went to black - down to its death - again

by fire - Aug. 23, 1853. Last use I have is
Apr. 13, 1853.

Lot 474 - Lower left diagonal half of 12c, used to pay the single 6c rate from Sonora, Calif. to Ellsworth, Maine. The stamp canc. "Sonora California Jan 7, 1852" in blue, this covers the cut edge and is clearly applied and repeated on the cover which is also marked "Paid 6 cts" in Mss. This lot also includes a very fine 3c 1851 cover addressed to the same party in Maine and bears two very fine orange-brown's which are tied on with an odd canc. of short dashes. It is canc. with the circular Sonora, Cal. pmk. and marged "Paid 6cts" in manuscript like the bisected cover. Both covers remarkably fine, extremely rare.

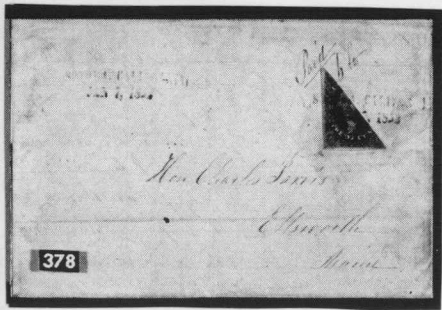

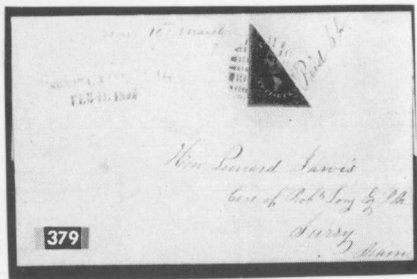
