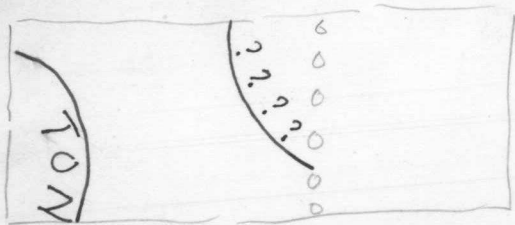

straight edge at left - width of stamp is
too wide to have had a vertical perf at left

Under date of Dec. 21st, 1944 Harry Keffer submitted a H.S. of 3 of 1¢ 1857 - Plate 4 - Type IIIA. pair to left was imperf between, that is, the holes were not fully punched out. Price was 225 net. I sent it to Mr. N., who bid him \$175. for it.
