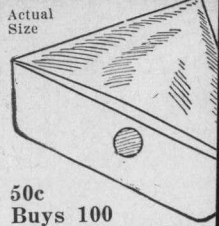

We think two additional 1c stamps of the 1851-1860 series should be given recognition by the Standard catalogue. To our way of thinking these are just as important as some of the types now listed. We refer to the 1c from plate 1

late, position 89R1 late. The stamp is recut at the top but at the bottom the circular frame line is badly broken for quite a distance and would constitute a Type IIIa if from an earlier plate. This is the only stamp on the sheet of 200 with such a break and is worthy of being listed as a Type IVa.

The second variety to which we refer is a type that we would designate as Va. These are found on plate 6 of the perforated stamp and instead of having the side ornaments partly missing, have nearly complete ornaments on the right. Most stamps from plate 6 show this variety. We find several stamps of plate 7 somewhat similar. If one should take a stamp, for instance, of Type V from plate 10, which is the commonest stamp in unused condition, and compare it with most of the stamps from plate 6 the difference can be readily seen. Ashbrook designated this as Type Va some years back but for some reason it has never been added to the catalogue.

We are still anxious to record the existence of a block of four from plate 6 but so far have not been successful.
