Ward wrote 1/16/50:

"Regarding the 5¢ brick red it was shown me by Steele who asked what I would pay for it. It was not in pretty condition, it had no gum and as I mentioned to you previously, a couple of the stamps were stained in such a way that it would really look nicer if broken into one block of four with a pair and block of three left over. Steele asked me what I would give for it and I asked him if it was for sale. He said "no" and I simply said \$500 or \$600 but that if it was actually for sale I would make a definite offer to the owner and pay Steele a commission.

He said he had not purchased it but that it would run more than he could afford. As far as I know it has not been sold but the owner evidently thinks I tried to kill it and has stayed away from me. Best regards,"
